

## **Federal Student Loan Code of Conduct**

The American University of Paris' code of conduct for US education loans is as follows:

In order to prohibit a conflict of interest with the responsibilities of an agent with respect to private education loans, all agents at the American University of Paris with responsibility for US loans are prohibited from the following:

- Revenue-sharing arrangements with any lender;
- Receiving gifts from a lender, a guarantor, or a loan servicer;
- Contracting arrangements providing financial benefit from any lender or affiliate of a lender;
- Directing borrowers to particular lenders or refusing or delaying loan certifications;
- Offers of funds for private loans;
- Call center or financial aid office staffing assistance;
- Advisory board compensation.

All agents with responsibility for US loans are reminded at least annually of the code.
